- 1. Begin and end on time! Do your best to come prepared for each session. Please come even if you are not able to complete the lesson.
- 2. Be on time! Please be seated by 9:15 each week. We will start on time. There is usually a lot to cover, so we need to be aware that time is important.
- 3. Remember we are not here to judge others but to learn more about God's word and how it applies to our daily lives.
- 4. Try to participate. It is important for you to share with the group what the Holy Spirit has revealed to you so we may all grow in our faith.
- 5. Be helpful to the Small Group Leader in keeping the discussion focused and in encouraging all to participate.
- 6. Do not monopolize the discussion. Give each person a chance to share. Try to connect your comments to those of others who have spoken.
- 7. Pray for one another! Please sign the back of each group member's prayer card and use the card as a bookmark as a reminder to lift up each woman in prayer as you complete your lessons.
- 8. We will end each week with a short Closing Prayer allowing time for prayer requests.
